PROPOSAL

As it reads now:

A - MANDATORY FUNDRAISERS

1. Each League member who attends a mandatory fundraiser, or who paid the fee for that fundraiser in advance, shall get credited four (4) wins added to their stat total.

a. Not to exceed 16 for a season.

b. Not to exceed 16 for a team for a given fundraiser.

2. If a member attends the first fundraiser in-person, they would pay the fee \$10 for that fundraiser and then \$20 for each of the remaining three if they want to pre-pay. (I.e. Fundraisers are \$10 each, then the total would be \$10 + \$20 + \$20 + \$20 = \$70).

3. If a member does not attend the first fundraiser but rather sends a representative in their place, they would pay \$80 for all four fundraisers (I.e. Fundraisers are \$20 each, then the total would be 4 x \$20 = \$80).

4. If a member chose not to attend any fundraiser following the first mandatory fundraiser, but rather

send a representative in their place, they would pay double the fees for that particular fundraiser only.

5. If a guest (or walk in) plays at a mandatory fundraiser and subsequently joins Long Beach Pool League, they will be given credit for the fundraiser and awarded four wins provided they pay \$10 plus any required table fees.

Change to:

A - FUNDRAISERS

1. Each League member who attends a fundraiser, or who paid the fee for that fundraiser in advance, shall get credited four (4) wins added to their stat total.

a. Not to exceed 24 for a season.

b. Not to exceed 16 for a team for a given fundraiser.

c. You only have the option to pay for ALL fundraisers at the FIRST fundraiser of the season. d.

There will be six (6) credited fundraisers on your stats, but only four (4) fundraisers are required for qualifying

2. If a member attends the first fundraiser in-person, they would pay the fee \$10 for that fundraiser and then \$20 for each of the remaining three if they want to pre-pay. (Ie. Fundraisers are \$10 each, then the total would be $\$10 + \$20 + \$20 + \$20 = \$70$). Or for the six fundraisers it would be \$10 for that fundraiser and \$20 for each of the remaining five if they want to pre-pay (Ie. Fundraisers are \$10 each then the total would be $\$10 + \$20 + \$20 + \$20 + \$20 + \$20 = \$110$).. **Note.. you have the option to pay for the 4 required fundraisers to qualify now OR pay for ALL (6) now.**

3. If a member does not attend the first fundraiser but rather sends a representative in their place, they would pay \$80 for all four fundraisers (Ie. Fundraisers are \$20 each, then the total would be $4 \times \$20 = \80). Or \$120 for all six. (Ie. Fundraisers are \$20 each, then the total would be $6 \times \$20 = \120)...

Note.. you have the option to pay for the 4 required fundraisers to qualify now OR pay for ALL (6) now.

4. If a member chose not to attend any fundraiser following the first mandatory fundraiser, but rather send a representative in their place, they would pay double the fees for that particular fundraiser only.

5. If a guest (or walk in) plays at a mandatory fundraiser and subsequently joins Long Beach Pool League, they will be given credit for the fundraiser and awarded four wins provided they pay \$10 plus any required table fees.
